Scholarship Name: Smith Christian Service Foundation Scholarship

About the Scholarship: The Smith Family Christian Foundation was founded when the Smith family (LIFE alumni & former Foursquare reverends) sold their church and directed the proceeds into a scholarship fund. The Foundation wants to help Christians who are going into any field (Graduate students preferred).

Award Range: \$150-\$5,000

Who can Apply: Graduate students with a minimum GPA of 3.0 who are U.S. citizens

When to Apply: Applications should be received by the organization no later than October 1st, however the committee will still receive scholarship materials year round

How to Apply: Complete application, have it edited, mail to address on application

Application Standards: Applicants are expected to provide a well thought out and written application. Incomplete or poorly written applications may be rejected. LPC encourages students to set up an appointment with the Writing Center, or have a friend proof read application materials before submitting. A Writing Center appointment can be set up by emailing writingcenter@lifepacific.edu. Professor Mark Schwartz is in charge of the Writing Center.

Award Distribution: Awards are distributed to LPC for applying to selected recipients' student accounts in February the following year.

Internal Process: *Award letters are sent directly to scholarship recipients by the Foundation. After that, the Foundation mails the donation to LPC. The check is processed by Advancement as a Foundation gift, and coded as a non-endowed designated scholarship. Advancement notifies Financial Aid, and will seek letters of gratitude from recipients in order to provide donor care to the Foundation.*
