Campus Visit Health & Wellness Protocols

Life Pacific University is open to prospective students and families to visit campus. To maintain the health and safety of our community, LPU is requiring all students, staff, faculty, and visitors to comply with protocols as recommended by the CDC, State of California, and County of Los Angeles. The university is requiring the following:

1. Campus visits are offered by appointment only to ensure our staff and facilities are well prepared. We are not able to accommodate walk-in visitors. Please schedule a visit at <https://www.lifepacific.edu/visit> or call (909) 706-3012.
2. Campus visits are limited to one individual or family unit at a time. Visits will be limited to 6 per day to ensure proper accommodations can be made.
3. All students, staff, faculty, and visitors are required to wear masks while on campus. Visitors are asked to bring their own mask. Masks will be available for visitors who do not have their own.
4. Visitors who traveled together do not need to maintain social distancing but must stay six feet away from other individuals on campus.
5. All individuals will be subject to temperature checks upon arrival. Temperature will be checked using a contactless thermometer and those with a temperature at or above 100 degrees Fahrenheit will be asked to leave campus.
6. Anyone displaying COVID-19 symptoms (cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, fever, chills, sore throat, etc.) may be asked to leave campus.
7. Hand sanitizer will be available at multiple locations throughout campus, including but not limited to, the admissions lobby and meeting rooms. All individuals are encouraged to wash hands and use sanitizer frequently.
