		Interpersonal Communication: Principles and theories of communication in personal, social and professional contexts.	AAGS, BABA, BAC (required), BAHDP (recommended), BWAM
Math Requirement	3	College level math course: business math, college algebra, statistics, accounting, or economics	AAGS, BABS, BATM, BAWAM

Open Electives	0-18	Any college-level course not applicable to a specific degree requirement	BABS (18 units), BATM (14 units), BABA (14 units), BAHDP (13 units), BAWAM (13)

LPU Transfer Policies

- Classes are transferred on a course-by-course basis.
- Credit is given to courses taken at another institution that match our basic content and emphasis.
- Courses must have at least half the credit of our equivalent course in order to fulfill the specific LPU course requirement.
- All quarter units will be converted to semester units. LPU grants 2 semester units for every 3 quarter units.
- Students must complete transfer work with a C- or better. Grades are transferred from accredited institutions.
- All courses must be college-level. Remedial courses will not be transferred.
